- FALL 2017 GPA OF 2.5 OR HIGHER
- CANNOT BE ON ACADEMIC OR DISCIPLINARY PROBATION (INCLUDES RESIDENCE LIFE)
- STUDENTS WHO ARE GRADUATING IN MAY 2018 WILL HAVE PREFERENCE
- BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDENTS CAN ALSO APPLY, IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN A MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM IN EDUCATION

## Title III Grant Program
