








Overall, there was a total of 128 students who signed in for New Student Orientation. Chart bellows indicates that there was 128, 100% students.












New Student Orientation- Fall 2015 Campus Map




Fall 2015 NSO consisted of 128 students, and were split up into four groups to attend different sessions. The Rotation map above shows where students were on campus to attend each session.






