AMP Scholar Benefits:

<u>Stipends</u>: To encourage high academic achievement, ANLSAMP scholars will receive a stipend based on their cumulative GPA and must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 to be eligible for an AMP stipend:

- For a cumulative GPA of 2.5 up to a 3.0 = \$1,200 per student per academic year (\$600 per semester).
- For a cumulative GPA of 3.0 up to a 3.5 = \$2,400 per student per academic year (\$1,200 per semester).
- For a cumulative GPA of 3.5 and above = \$3,600 per student per academic year (\$1,800 per semester).

Additional Opportunities: Attend AIHEC conference or other professional STEM conferences with expenses paid.

Note: Health Occupation & Public Health majors are not eligible.
