A 10-week program designed to prepare Native American undergraduate college students for careers in public health and health research.

The program has three stages:

Stage 1 Intensive 3-week training in Public Health Research Methods at Diné College, Tsaile, AZ

Stage 2 Six-week mentored internship in student's home community

Stage 3 One week data analysis workshop and presentation at Diné College, Tsaile, AZ

While participating in SREP, students receive the following:

- \$5,760 stipend (distributed in installments)
- 7 transferrable college credits hours in Public Health (4 classroom and 3 practicum)
- Tuition, books and materials for the Public Health courses required for SREP
- Room and board while at the Diné College Tsaile campus






