



2022-23 Student Research Showcase

Native Science Report, an online journal reporting on trends in STEM education within tribal and Native-serving colleges and universities, invites submissions to its 2022-23 undergraduate Student Research Showcase. Up to five examples of student research will be selected for publication. Each published paper will receive a \$500 award.

Submission Requirements

Student research conducted as part of a course or through independent study completed under supervision of a faculty member is eligible for submission. Topics should be related to one of the STEM disciplines (but can include the social sciences). Submissions should not exceed ten double-spaced pages, including references and illustrations.

Eligibility

The showcase is open to undergraduate students enrolled in a tribally controlled or Native-serving college or university eligible for NSF-TCUP funding. Students who are no longer enrolled are also eligible as long as the research submitted was completed while enrolled in a tribal or eligible Native-serving institution.

Research completed as part of a cooperative program between a TCU and a mainstream university (e.g. a summer research experience for tribal college students conducted at a mainstream university) is also eligible.

Criteria for Selection

Submissions will be selected for publication based on three broad criteria:

1. Quality and clarity of the writing.
2. Quality of the research.
3. Choice of research topics. The research topic is novel, relevant to community concerns, and/or advances knowledge within the discipline.

Please note that *Native Science Report* is not a refereed journal and submissions will not be judged on research merit alone. Instead, we are looking for submissions that, in broad terms, illustrate the creativity and diversity of research projects undertaken by students as part of their undergraduate education within tribal and Native-serving colleges. We welcome a wide range of submissions. Alternative formats (such as video) are also welcome.

Awards

Up to five submissions will receive a \$500 award and be published in *Native Science Report*. Judging will be overseen by *Native Science Report* editorial staff and members of its editorial advisory board.

Deadline for Submission

Please send submissions by May 31, 2023 for consideration. Awards will be announced by the end of summer. Winning submissions will be published sequentially, starting in the fall of 2023.
