## Job Description:

This summer position will provide hospital, laboratory, and research support for the Zoological Health Program. The main focus of this position is to assist with retrospective clinical data collection including medical record searching and data extraction, literature review and library maintenance, and organization and evaluation of preventive medicine programs. Additional duties will include assisting veterinary technicians with hospital and laboratory maintenance and operation. The summer assistant will participate in instruction of the Little Zoo Vets Summer Program, which provides instruction to 8-13 year old children. The summer assistant will learn how to collect data from medical records, organize them for analysis, and prepare
them for publication. Co-authorship or acknowledgements in peer-reviewed publications are possible through this position. This position does not involve direct animal care duties or routine veterinary job shadowing.
