SUMMER RESEARCH ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

May 28, 2024 - August 01, 2024

A 10-week summer program designed to prepare Native American undergraduate college students for careers in public health and health research.



THE PROGRAM CONTAINS THREE STAGES:

STAGE 1: Intensive 3-week training in Public Health Research Methods at Diné College, Tsaile, AZ - Main Campus

STAGE 2: Six-week mentored internship in student's home community conducting research

STAGE 3:

One-week data analysis workshop and presentation back at Diné College, Tsaile, AZ -Main Campus

While participating in SREP, students receive the following:

- \$5, 760 stipend that is distributed installments throughout the program
 - 7 transferrable college credits in Public Health (4 classroom and 3 practicum)
- Tuition, books and material for the Public Health courses required for SREP
- Room and board while at the Diné College, Tsaile Campus
