Academic Sii Hasin Committee End-Of-Year Report, AY 2021-2022

Below is a summary of events and progress that was made for the ASHC for the academic year.

Annual Degree Program Assessment Reports

ASHC Representatives and School Deans have been informed about missing DPAR1s and DPAR2s. Please see Table 3.

Feedback was provided to program leads for their DPAR2s from their School committee representatives this year, and updated/improved DPAR2s were submitted and uploaded by reps as necessary. Table 1.

Due to pandemic issues, quorum was not reached for many bimonthly meetings during the Spring semester, 2022. Therefore, DPAR1 feedback to program reps and Deans were not provided. Table 1.

The low turnout for DPARs is possibly due to the former Director of Assessment retiring, who usually uploaded the DPARs for the committee representatives. Efforts will be made during the summer and Fall semester of 2022 to ascertain and upload these DPARs if they have been done. Training should be given to the representatives to ensure they know how to upload the DPAR documents to the website. At the beginning of the academic year, IT was informed of current personnel on the committee, and permission was granted to the committee representatives to upload DPARs. Difficulty with DPAR1s being done could also have been due to our Program Coordinators being dismissed in summer, 2021, due to their Title 3 grant ending, because they were collecting and storing artifacts.

Other noteworthy events.

Carrie Kaye Tsosie-Jim was hired as a consultant to help with the duties that the former Director of Assessment did. She met with the ASHC several times during the year to provide feedback and answer questions about assessment.

Watermarks is a software program that the College has purchased to house assessment information. The Provost, Dr. Geraldine Garrity, advised the ASHC to become familiar with Watermarks and design Blackboard assessments to automatically be uploaded to Watermarks. ASHC was supposed to get training on this did not occur, and will now wait until next year.

ASHC voted Don Robinson to resume being Chair this year while outgoing Chair, Rosalind Smith, assumed being Chair of Faculty Association. Gabriela Cruz was maintained as the Secretary. No Chair has been named for next year.

## **ASHC Recommendation:**

It should be pointed out that the ASHC needs the support of the Provost and the Deans to encourage the faculty to stay up to date with the DPAR1 Reports and to be more serious about assessment. These supervisors are the only ones that can provide realistic oversight and encouragement to do assessment properly. It should also be mentioned that the Deans or Department Chair in the School should be more involved with the academic details of each program so that more detailed oversight and direction can be supplied by the Provost and Deans or Department Chair.

It is recommended that program leads be given time and training to set up their matrices and assessment programs on Watermarks. Without time and training, there is little chance that the already over-worked faculty will have time for this, and the College will be wasting money on the Watermarks program that is not used.
