He is the author of many books and pamphlets of poetry, including two editions of *Selected Writings* (Ugly Duckling Presse, 2003 & 2005), *Expensive Magic* (House Press, 2008), *Stranger in Town* (City Lights, 2010), *Language Arts* (Wave Books, 2014), *All This Time* (Wave Books, 2021), and most recently *Siren of Atlantis* (Wave Books, 2025). In 2022, he received a Grants to Artists award from the Foundation for Contemporary Arts. He has taught all over the country, including at the University of Washington, Bard College, Washington University, Naropa University, and the Institute of American Indian Arts. He lives in Lofall, Washington.
